

2020 - Cadastral Law Examination Results

The 2020 Cadastral Law Examination results have been notified to candidates. Sixty-seven candidates sat the examination.

Congratulations to the candidates who passed the exam this year. It was very pleasing to see the consistent high standard continuing from year to year.

In 2020, 22% of candidates achieved a mark of 70 or higher in the examination. By comparison in both 2018 and 2019 this number was 27%.

In 2020, 42% of candidates achieved a mark between 60%-69%. By comparison in 2019 this number was 20%, whilst in 2018 it was 33%.

The top mark in 2020 was 87%. By comparison in both 2018 and 2019 this number was 90%.

The Examinations Committee now look forward to seeing the candidates that passed attending the Professional examinations in the future.

A big thank you to the Laws and Regulations Panel examiners who dedicated many volunteer hours preparing the exam, marking and re-marking the exam papers. This year there were two examiners who prepared the questions and an independent moderator who reviewed the exam. Without their dedication to the exam process the profession would not be able to maintain the high standards we set for ourselves.

Thanks to all the businesses who provided a venue and support persons to supervise the exam.
