You will also organise and lead field surveys, sharing your expertise with less experienced members of the team.

In a time of rapid technological change, you will help shape the strategic direction of New Zealand's geodetic system, ensuring that it meets regulatory requirements as well as the evolving needs of surveyors and other users.

Key selection criteria includes:

- Substantial field experience in geodetic or cadastral surveying, as well as processing/analysing/presenting the data collected in such surveys
- Strong technical knowledge of New Zealand's cadastral system and its relationship with the geodetic system
- Proven ability to build and maintain relationships with surveyors and other spatial professionals who are key users of the geodetic system
