2021 - Cadastral Law Examination Results

The 2021 Cadastral Law Examination results have been notified to candidates. Fifty-two candidates sat the examination this year.

Congratulations to the candidates who passed the exam this year. It was very pleasing to see again the consistent high standard continuing from year to year.

In this year's examination, 83% of the candidates achieved a "pass" of 60% or higher, a significant improvement from last year. By comparison in 2020, only 64% of the candidates achieved a "pass" of 60% or higher.

Of this year's candidates, 13 candidates, being 25% of the candidates, achieved a mark of 80% or over. Top mark for this year's examination was 89%. By comparison the top mark in 2020 was 87%.

The Examinations Committee now look forward to seeing the candidates that passed attending the Professional examinations in the future.

A big thank you to the Laws and Regulations Panel examiners who dedicated many volunteer hours preparing the exam, marking and re-marking the exam papers. This year there were two examiners who prepared the questions and an independent moderator who reviewed the exam. Without their dedication to the exam process the profession would not be able to maintain the high standards we set for ourselves.

Thanks to all the businesses who provided a venue and support persons to supervise the exam.
